Project Learning Tree

Early Childhood Workshop

Preschool educators and early childhood specialists are invited to try their hands at a wide variety of activities they can use to engage children in outdoor play and exploration. This two-part Project Learning Tree (PLT) Early Childhood Educators Workshop will meet at the Indiana Dunes State Park Nature. The workshop is specifically designed for educators who work with children ages three to six. Topics include exploring nature with five senses, meeting neighborhood trees, and experiencing trees through the seasons. Each educator who completes the entire workshop, attending both sessions, will receive Project Learning Tree's Environmental Experiences for Early Childhood, an activity guide filled with over 130 exciting experiences. These activities are aligned with the accreditation programs of the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) and the Head Start Child Outcomes Framework. A music CD accompanies the guide and features songs from children's musician Billy B. Brennan that encourage children to sing, dance, and move.

The workshop is co-sponsored by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources Division of Forestry, the Dunes Region of the Indiana Association for the Education of Young Children, Indiana Dunes State Park, Dunes Learning Center, and Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore.
