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Non Formal CDA Project
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The Indiana Non Formal Child Development Associate® (CDA) Project Scholarship, in partnership with the Monroe County Community Schools Corporation/ Adult Education Program is pleased to announce the availability of scholarships for the upcoming Child Development Associate® (CDA) Credential course.

To be eligible for the scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Be a resident of Indiana who is at least 18 years of age.
- ✓ High School Diploma or High School Equivalency (HSE).
- ✓ Employed in a child care center, child care home, or child care ministry that is licensed, registered, or certified as a LLEP CCDF provider by OECOSL.
- ✓ Be working 25+ hours/week in Indiana.
- ✓ Earn \$25/hr or less as a teacher/teacher assistant, family child care owner OR director/administrator.
- ✓ Have a completed/updated criminal history and background check on file with FSSA, OECOSL.
- ✓ Have reliable internet access and a computer to fully participate in the course and be successful.
